

Job Description for Music Instructors – Sierra Music Academy

About Sierra Music Academy:

Sierra Music Academy provides private music lessons to students in the towns of Roseville, Rocklin, and Granite Bay (suburbs of Sacramento, CA). Teaching Responsibilities:

Provide 30 minute to 60 minute weekly music lessons to students of all ages and abilities. Instructors will teach at our school and travel to students' homes for lessons (all in close proximity). Assess student skill and music knowledge during initial meeting and provide appropriate teaching of music theory and instrument instruction so that students can progress toward their musical goals.

Instructors will be expected to prepare students for student recitals. In addition to attending these recitals, instructors may be asked to help arrange and perform at the school's recitals and other events.

Minimum Qualifications:

We're looking for applicants who have taken music courses in college. Applicants should have at least 2-3 years of experience teaching students of various ages and abilities.

Applicants should possess strong communication skills and effective personal skills for working with students who range from young children to adults. Applicants should have effective time management skills to ensure that appointments are met on time and be highly organized to keep track of any changes to their weekly schedule.

Instructors will need to own their own car, possess a valid driver's license, and show proof of automobile insurance.

Compensation:

Dependent on experience and qualifications (we generally compensate teachers in the range of \$26 to \$28 per hour of instruction). Pay for performances will vary (usually in the range of \$75-\$100 per hour).
